Whereas, the HP Staff Selection Commission, Hamirpur has issued a **Advertisement vide Advertisement No. 33-1/2017 dated 08.02.2017** in which 119 posts of Clerk under 20% quota of Limited Direct Recruitment from eligible regular class- IV employees of government departments of HP were advertised.

Whereas, the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh has issued Notification No. Per (AP.B) B(15)-5/2014 dated 17.04.2017 regarding discontinue/ dispense with the process of holding interviews in respect of direct recruitment for making recommendations for Class III & IV posts/ services under the State Govt. with immediate effect.

Whereas, the clarification regarding division of 2.5 marks allocated for minimum educational qualifications as per R & P Rules and the competent authorities for issuance of various types of certificates on the basis of which evaluation is to be done has been received on dated 18.07.2017.

Therefore, the selection to class-III posts under the State Govt. shall accordingly be made henceforth on the basis of merit of written examination followed by evaluation, based on the following parameters:-

i)	Weightage for the minimum educational qualification as per the Recruitment & Promotion Rules. (Percentage of marks obtained in the educational qualification would be multiplied by 0.025. For example, an individual has secured 50 % marks in the required educational qualifications, he /she will be allowed 1.25 marks (50 X 0.025 = 1.25))	2.5 (two & a half)	
ii)	Belonging to notified Backward Area or Panchayat, as the case may be	1 (one)	Concerned SDO (Civil) / Tehsildar/Naib Tehsildar
iii)	Land less family / family having land less than 1 Hectare to be certified by the concerned Revenue Authority	1(one)	Concerned SDO (Civil) / Tehsildar/Naib Tehsildar
iv)	Non-employment Certificate to the effect that none of the family members is in Government/Semi Government.	1(one)	Concerned SDO(Civil)/Tehsildar/Naib Tehsildar

xi)	Experience up to a maximum of 5 years in Govt./ semi-Govt. organization relating to the post applied for (0.5 mark only for each completed year).	2.5 (two and a half)	The competent authority of the concerned Govt./ semi Govt. organization

3. The Mode of selection (Syllabus):

- i) Objective type screening test (MCQ) consisting of General English of 10+2 standard, and Hindi of Matric Standard, General Knowledge including General Knowledge of Himachal Pradesh, Current Affairs, Everyday Science, Social Science, General awareness & Logic.
- ii) Typing Skill Test on computer with minimum speed of 25 words per minute in English or 20 words per minute in Hindi will be of qualifying nature for those who qualify the written objective type screening test.
